staff need to be aware of?



**PATIENT-SPECIFIC
RISKS**

Is there anything about this visit that
requires special preparation or additional
support?



**LOCATION &
SURROUNDINGS**

Know where you are going, where you can
safely park, and how you will enter and exit.
Be aware of your surroundings.



**WEATHER
CONDITIONS**

Check the forecast. Be prepared for rain,
snow, heat, cold, wind, or storms.
Adjust your plans if needed.



**WHEN IN DOUBT,
REACH OUT**

Call your manager or team if you have
questions or concerns. It's okay to pause,
reschedule, or ask for help.
